Directions to Port Angeles

Hopefully you have a State of Washington road map. If not, be sure to get one from the car rental agency.

There are a couple of ways to get to the Olympic Peninsula and Port Angeles.

You could take Interstate 5 south to Tacoma and take Hwy 16 across the Tacoma Narrows Bridge. Follow Hwy 16 north. It will turn into Hwy 3 near Bremerton. Follow Hwy 3 north to Hwy 104 and cross the Hood Canal Bridge. Keep following Hwy 104 West. It will merge with Hwy 101 and take you right into Port Angeles. Driving time is about 2.5 to 3 hours.

Alternatively you could take a ferry boat from downtown Seattle to Bainbridge Island. Once on Bainbridge follow the main road (SR 305) to Hwy 3. Take Hwy 3 north to 104 and the Hood Canal Bridge and continue to Port Angeles as above. Travel time is about 2.5 - 3.5 hours depending on the ferry schedule.

Another ferry leaves from Edmonds, about 20 minutes north of Seattle. Take Interstate 5 north to exit 177 (or 178, just follow the signs to Hwy 104, Edmonds/Kingston ferry). On the Kingston side follow the main road, Hwy 104, to the Hood Canal Bridge and continue to Port Angeles as above. Travel time 2.5 to 3.5 hours depending on the ferry schedule.
